

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM OF IMA

Cross fertilization of ideas by process of migration of students to other institutes is an important aspect of pedagogy. This has evolved very strongly over the past few years and is popularly known as "Internship program". The IMA proposes to encourage students who wish to participate in this program for about 10 days during winter break and/or summer vacation.

(a) INTERNSHIP FOR STUDENTS OF IMA

Eligibility: A first year or second year completed B.Sc. (H) or first year completed M.Sc. student of IMA.

What the student is supposed to do? The student should contact and get consent letter from a mentor in some elite institute to study in his/her guidance for about 10 days during winter break and/or one month during summer vacation. The intern should study in the host institute and get a certificate of attendance after the completion of a term. At the end of summer term the intern shall be required to make a report of his/her work under the signature of the mentor to be submitted in IMA for evaluation. The student should arrange for own boarding and lodging during internship. Alternatively, the student may attend 3 to 4 week long training camp meant for them and conducted by eminent professors/ professionals.

Token support from IMA: Students intending to undertake internship in a reputed institution located more than 50 k. m.s from his/her home town and IMA; shall be reimbursed living allowance of Rs. 350/- per day and actual to and fro second class sleeper train fare or bus fare. For students pursuing internship within 50 k.m.s of home town and IMA; living allowance of Rs. 100/- shall be provided. Financial support for students attending training camps shall be decided on case to case basis depending on the financial support from the host. A student of IMA can avail financial support at most once during period of study at IMA.

Selection Procedure: On application basing on merit.

(b) FOR EXTERAL STUDENTS

About the Scheme: The IMA proposes to admit about six interns from outside IMA institutions for one month duration during summer vacation. The interns

are expected to do intensive reading, library work and consultation with a teacher mentor of IMA on a subject suggested by the mentor. Students having attitude to work hard for higher studies beyond syllabus material are encouraged to apply.

Eligibility: The intern should be a first year completed M.Sc. Mathematics student (or 4th year completed student of integrated B.Sc.-M.Sc. (Mathematics)course) of an institution of India. Gifted students who have completed first year or second year of a B.Sc.(H) in mathematics (or 1st year or 2nd year completed student of integrated B. Sc.-M. Sc. (Mathematics) course) are also eligible.

Selection: The student of should arrange a consent letter from a teacher of IMA to study in his/her guidance for one month during summer vacation. He/ she should apply attaching the consent letter to the following e-mail address: internship@iomaorissa.ac.in.

Accommodation: The selected interns shall be accommodated in IMA hostel on request on payment of a fee of Rs. 5000.00(Rupees Five thousand only) to cover boarding and accommodation expenses for 30 days.
